
Instructions to make the Zipper Poncho

- 1. Take 1 piece of polar fleece or similar weight fabric measuring 62"x 35"
- 2. Cut a lengthwise 30" cut down the centre of the fabric to the mid-point (this will be where you will insert the zipper)
- 3. Cut an oval hole for the head measuring 10" x 5"
- 4. Sew a 1" hem around all outside edges (fabric should now measure ~60" x 33")
- 5. Sew a $\frac{1}{2}$ " hem around the hole for the neck
- 6. Fold back the fabric around the lengthwise cut and insert the zipper



Instructions to make the Button-up vest (male/female)

- 1. Take 1 piece of light cotton or similar shirt weight fabric measuring 45"x 35"
- 2. Cut the fabric in half lengthwise to create 2 pieces of fabric measuring 45" x 17.5"
- 3. Cut a half oval hole for the head on each piece to measure approx 5" x 5"
- 4. Sew a 1" hem along all outside edges
- 5. Sew a $\frac{1}{2}$ " hem along the edges of the neck hole.
- 6. Fold back the fabric down the cut side by 1" and hem
- 7. Attach 5 flat ¾" buttons spaced 3.5" apart along the inside edge of one piece of fabric (Do this again on the other side of the neck hole
- 8. Make corresponding button holes along the inside edge of the other piece of fabric
- 9. Mark the fabric to indicate which side buttons for male (buttons on R) vs female (buttons on L)
